## 5. TEMPORARY ROAD/FOOTPATH CLOSURES, CREATIONS/DIVERSIONS

- Temporary Road Closure part of Naas Lane at the Naas Lane Level Crossing for a
  distance of approximately 50 metres. Road is expected to be closed from 22:00
  HRS on 9 March 2019 until 10:00 HRS on 10 March 2019 or until the works have
  been completed.
- Full Road Closure Old Dam Road, Oldcroft. From the junction with Allaston Road to Pumping Station (approximately 50 metres) from 5 June 2019 to 7 June 2019.

• S106 Agreements - Cllr Preest advised that he had requested that Gloucestershire County Council provide details of the contributions which would be gained via S106 Agreements. Cllr Preest also informed Members that Gloucestershire County Council felt that they were losing out due to the lack of Community Infrastructure Levy in the Forest of Dean. Cllr Pearman spoke in favour of Gloucestershire County Council and the Local Planning Authority providing the Town Council with a list of contributions which would be gained via S106 Agreements, as such information could possibly be utilised in funding bids to improve the high street. Cllr Preest expressed thanks to the Legal Department of Gloucestershire County Council for resolving the issue which had prevented the implementation of the bus link for Oakdale. Cllr Preest advised Members that from April 2019 Stagecoach had agreed to take over the routes which were currently operated by a local bus contractor.

Members noted that prior to the meeting they had been provided with a copy of Variation Order 2019 – Bus Lane Order 2017 – Cambourne Place which had been received from Gloucestershire County Council. Cllr Ives requested that said Order be displayed on Lydney Town Council's Facebook Page in order that members of the public may be informed.

#### 14. PLANNING CORRESPONDENCE

- Members noted Cllr Preest's decision not to further contact GAPTC concerning CIL.
- Mr M Hoare/Forest of Dean District Council Members were provided with a copy of the e-mail exchange between Mr Hoare, Forest of Dean District Council and Lydney Town Council. Members were advised that Mr Hoare had contacted Lydney Town Council for support as he was experiencing problems with the marketing name used for one of the new housing developments, which was the same name as his previously approved development. During discussion the discrepancy was highlighted between the guidance for developers regarding naming of developments and what appeared to have taken place. Cllr Preest advised that he awaited a response from the Officer at Forest of Dean District Council as to why it appeared that the guidance had not been followed and he gave a commitment to contact the Head of Paid Services at said Authority if no response was forthcoming.

#### 15. COUNCILLORS REPORTS

Cllr Preest voiced concern over the poor condition of the footpath (FLY9/10) which it was felt was due to building work conducted on a house in Bream Road. Cllr Preest advised that he had requested Forest of Dean District Council to investigate the matter and had requested the Local Highway Manager, Gloucestershire County Council to revisit the site due to the mud which continued to be deposed on the highway.

Cllr Harris noted that since the last meeting Forest of Dean District Council had erected CCTV cameras in Newerne Street Car Park, however, these had been vandalised within days. Cllr Harris felt that cameras had been poorly sited, as they could easily be accessed by unauthorised persons. Cllr Preest felt that serious representation should be made to Forest of Dean District Council to ascertain if the cameras were working and if they were not, when they would be repaired. Cllr Harris advised that vehicles were still using the car park as a meeting place and driving anti-socially. The CEO was therefore requested to make enquiries of Forest of Dean District Council regarding the current operational status of the cameras.
