3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

 regard the incident to be of a serious nature; they, alongside the Council's Solicitor are
 actioning the case accordingly.
- Members were advised that the Council would be required to meet the legal costs incurred as a result of its Solicitor gaining a civil injunction with powers of arrest (if deemed necessary/when applied for); whilst this sum was currently not known, action to "protect" Lydney Town Council Members/Officers was in line with prior approval.
