1. **APOLOGIES**

2. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

3. **OPEN FORUM**

A member of the public asked how she could view the subsequent Trust meetings and was advised that the same Zoom link would work for all three meetings.

A member of the Council asked whether the Standing Orders allowed only residents of Lydney to speak in the Open Forum and the Clerk was able to advise that Standing Orders 3 (d) and 3 (e) allowed 'members of the public' to attend, make representations etc. without being limited to residents.

4. **REPLACEMENT OF THE HAYTER MOWER**

The Council received the Town Clerk's report, which outlined the options for acquiring a replacement for the Hayter mower, which was beyond economic repair and unanimously RESOLVED:

- (i) that the Council acquire a Rotary Mower with 72" bed and road homologation kit under a five-year lease, having first considered the options for (a) purchasing a new or second-hand machine (b) leasing a replacement machine;
- (ii) that the Council notes the Head Gardener / Grounds Foreman's report on the extra work that could be taken on by acquiring a machine with greater capacity / efficiency than the Hayter mower it will replace;
- (ii) that the Council notes the assessment that the cost-savings from taking over existing mowing contracts for the work to be done 'in-house' will either offset the cost of a purchase or wholly pay for a lease (with effect from 1st April 2021).

5. **RE-OPENING THE HIGH STREETS – PROMOTIONAL VIDEO**

The Council was requested to consider whether to commission a professional video from Wye Dean Tourism as part of the package of measures in support of 'Re-opening Our High Streets Safely' The offer to each of the four Forest towns was to compile the video, along with four shorter clips for social media, a list of shops on the high street and a list of local events for £2,500. The Council RESOLVED to accept the offer with the following Record of Voting: For -7, Against -0, Absentions -2, Absent/Apologies -2, Vacant seats -4
