1. APOLOGIES

Apologies were noted from Trustees R Holmes, S Holmes, Leach and Vaughan.

2. <u>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST</u> None.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Trustee Kemsley Proposed the acceptance of the Minutes of the meeting of the Trust held on the 22nd March 2021 as a correct record. Seconded by Trustee Stockham. APPROVED.

4. FINANCIAL MATTERS

4.1 To consider the unaudited accounts for the year end 31st March 2021.

Proposed by Trustee S Holmes, Seconded by Trustee Carr, APPROVED. The Trust Secretary advised that unallocated funds from 2020/21 of £20,269.88 had been carried forward due to unprecedented times with COVID and would not be expected to happen again.

4.2 TO CONSIDER THE SCHEDULE OF PAYMENTS

Acceptance Proposed by Trustee Kemsley, Seconded by Trustee Harley and unanimously APPROVED.

A discussion took place with regard to the new grass cutting contractor and areas that appeared not to have been maintained. The Trust Secretary explained the Head Groundsman had viewed the areas with the contractor before commencement but would ensure another meeting took place to fully understand the areas under the contract. The Trust was reminded that some areas were now being left for wildflowers to grow. One area identified belonged to Lydney Park Estate and contact would be made with them.

5. FUTURE OF THE TRUST

The Trust Secretary reiterated the Town Council's Solicitor had stated the assets of each Trust would need to remain in charity with the closure of one or the other Trust. The Trusts could be moved to a Charitable Incorporate Organisation (CIO), which would still ensure Lydney Town Council as sole Trustees, this would enable a new updated constitution.

A lengthy discussion took place looking at the advantages and disadvantages,

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with Trustees feeling it would be easier as a CIO to obtain Grants and help a wider participation from other stakeholders. The Legal implications to the Sports Club who lease from Lydney Recreation Trust would need to be investigated fully. Moving to a CIO would also ensure other groups could help in the management, with the Town Council retaining a majority. Trustees felt further clarification be asked of the Town Councils solicitors and be brought back for further decision making.

The Annual Play Inspection from Monmouthshire County Council was quoted at a cost of £135.27 and was agreed. Given the low value, it was AGREED that future orders for inspection could be dealt with by Officers.

7. <u>TO CONSIDER IF COST EFFECTIVE TO MOVE THE SKATEPARK ELECTRICITY</u> <u>SUPPLY FROM THE TENNIS CLUBHOUSE.</u>

The Trust Secretary advised that two quotes had been received, with a couple of thousand pounds difference. The main expenses being with regard to the electrical work, as the cable had not been buried deep enough and had been damaged. Proposed by Trustee Kemsley that another quote be sought to enable a decision to be made on best value for money, Seconded by Trustee S Holmes.

The Trust Secretary reported the Pump Track company were looking into previous suggested locations as well as new locations and would be putting a proposal together, which due to funding would take some time. Trustees felt the waste land owned by the Trust could be considered for use as a Community Project.
