1. **APOLOGIES**  
Councillor Greenwood sent his apologies.
  2. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

He reminded the Committee that the Council had no powers to endorse current speed limit but it had previously expressed an interest in mobile speed camera training; the Town Clerk would take this up with the Police again.

It was noted that depending on where benches were installed would determine who permission/approval needed to be sought. Agreed to DEFER to Amenities Committee for further consideration, with a request that a site visit be undertaken to determine sites. Once done, the appropriate permission(s) should be sought from the relevant bodies.
